### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Kansas City Board of Education **accept the low bid from US Engineering for plumbing replacement work in the amount of \$91,929.00** as submitted by Robert Young, Interim Executive Director of Business Services, Dr. Kelli Mather, Chief Operating Officer, and as recommended by Dr. Cynthia Lane, Superintendent of Schools.

### **EXPLANATION:**

#### **Background**

Sealed bids were received in the Purchasing Department Office on May 18, 2016. The solicitation called for the demolition of the existing water supply lines in the food service kitchen at Washington High School and replacement with new water supply lines. Bids were advertised in the District's approved publication, and on the District's website. Bids were received from Foley and US Engineering.

#### **Why this is important.**

Replacement of the existing water supply lines with new lines is to address issues related to the age of the lines, ongoing maintenance, and general efficiency in placement. Further, the replacement will improve water flow capacity and improve the efficiency of the nutritional services daily operations in the facility.

#### **Strategic Priority**

This improvement by replacement of building infrastructure addresses the priority of providing a safe and quality environment for learning and being good stewards of resources with financial accountability

#### **What Action is the Board Being Asked to Consider?**

It is requested the Board approve the low bid recommendation from US Engineering, meeting the requirements of the written bid.
