

Central Middle School Dress Code – 2021-22

Students are required to wear acceptable school uniforms in order to create a fair and equitable learning environment, as well as to promote school safety.

School uniform requirements:

Uniform Shirt

- Solid white, black, or navy Polo style shirt
- T-shirts may be worn underneath the uniform shirt, and they also must be white, black, or navy.

Sweaters or sweatshirts

- Plain pull-over, solid white, black, or navy are permitted
- Hoodies are **NOT** allowed
- Jackets or coats of any kind are **not allowed** other than travelling to/from the mobile classrooms.

Pants

- All pants, shorts, or skirts must be solid black, khaki, or navy
- NO jeans are allowed
- NO sweats, tights, yoga pants, stretch pants, or leggings/jeggings are allowed
- Shorts and skirts must be no more than 2” above the knee.

FOOTWEAR

- Students may not wear sandals, flip-flops, slides or slippers. Closed toes shoes only.

ACCESSORIES

- Hats are not allowed.

NOTE: Students new to Central will be allowed a 1-week grace period during which they must obtain uniform clothing.

Dress Down Guidelines

- Students are responsible for dressing in manner that is appropriate for school. It should not interfere with the educational process or cause disruption.
- Attire must be modest and may not be obscene, profane, lewd, vulgar, indecent, or offensive.
- No sagging, no shirts displaying midriff.
- Tops with spaghetti straps are not allowed.
- Hats are not to be worn inside the building at any time.
- Attire must not show evidence of gang membership or affiliation.
- Attire must not display anything related to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or sexual conduct, and must not include phrases/double meaning related to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or sexual conduct
- Hoodies are not allowed.
