# Healthy Learning and Work Environment

- Masks will be required of all students, staff, parents and visitors.
- Masks are required on school buses.
- Students or staff must stay home if they have COVID-19 symptoms.
- Custodians will engage in daily “continuous” cleaning, wiping down high touch points throughout the day to be followed by complete disinfecting of the building at night.
- To the best extent possible, social distancing will be implemented in the classrooms.



# Learning Modes

- Teachers will only teach in-person students.
- Virtual Learning will be available to 30 Elementary, 40 Middle School and 200 High School students through Greenbush. These are on top of licenses in use.
- Enrollment information will be provided through Student Services.
- Quarantined students will work on online materials for the period of the quarantine to maintain academic growth.

# Athletics and Outdoor Activities

- Campuses will be able to have outdoor activities.
- Open houses/Back to School events can be held, but it is highly recommended that grade levels are staggered to reduce the number of individuals on site.
- Athletics will follow KSHSAA guidelines and district mitigation practices where applicable.
- Spectators will be permitted to attend KSHSAA sponsored athletics and school activities.
- All Fine Arts and PE courses will be offered with mitigations and adaptations to instruction per local health department guidelines.
