**SUBJECT: ACCEPT LOW BID CHEMICAL WASTE DISPOSAL – HIGH SCHOOLS**

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**RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Kansas City Board of Education **accept bids from TradeBe in the amount of \$25,796.23 for Chemical Waste Disposal** as submitted by Wayne Correll, Director of Purchasing, Dr. Kelli Mather, Chief Operating Officer, and as recommended by Dr. Cynthia Lane, Superintendent of Schools.

**EXPLANATION:**

Background

In accordance with the requirements of Board Policy DJED (Bids and Quotations Requirements), These bids solicited contractors for disposal of chemical waste from FL Schlagle High School, JC Harmon High School, Sumner Academy, Washington High School and Wyandotte High School, in preparation for construction of academy spaces related to Diploma+ at each location. The chemicals that are the subject of the solicitation are those that have been stored in science lab cabinets and closets and custodial areas for in some instances for decades, and are no longer needed. Bids were received on February 21, 2018 in the Purchasing Department office. Bids were publically advertised in the District's approved publication, and posted to the District website. Five firms responded to a solicitation for each location respectively. Funding for the project will be paid from the district's general fund.

Why this is important.

Removal of hazardous materials in renovated sites is required by law to ensure the safety and protect the health of building occupants.

Strategic Framework Priority

This disposal of chemicals addresses the priorities of safe and respectful learning environments, and being good stewards of resources with financial accountability.

What Action is the Board Being Asked to Consider?

Approve low bids so that work may proceed with chemical waste disposal projects at Wyandotte High School, Washington High School, JC Harmon High School, Sumner Academy and FL Schlagle High School.
